

We want EVERYONE to have a good time at Piney River Escape, so we have some rules in place to ensure everyone's safety. Our Goal at Piney River Escape is for you to have a great and relaxing camping experience. Please follow the rules and regulations listed and enjoy our campground!

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Camping

- **Campers must be at least 18 years of age to rent a site. Site holders must have identification and proof of age, and furnish the full names of everyone in the camping party. The site holder is responsible for the conduct of everyone under 18 years old and is liable for any violations of the rules and regulations.**
- **All campers under 18 years old must be accompanied and supervised by the site holder.**
- **All campers will occupy and place equipment only on the assigned campsite.**
- **VISITORS are persons whom you have not registered on your site. They must stay with you in your trailer. No other camping vehicle or tent may be placed on your site for this purpose. Guests may obtain a rental site for their camper or tent (based on availability)**
- **You are responsible for your children. Please do not let them wander through other's site, or leave them unattended. Vandalism and disrespect for persons or property will not be tolerated.**
- **Please be courteous to your neighbors. Have fun but respect others – anyone acting abusive or causing trouble will be removed from the**
- **No sexually aggressive or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated.**
- **Quiet Time: No loud noise music is allowed at any hour. In addition, quiet time begins at 10:00 P.M. and ends at 7:00 A.M. Operation of vehicles should be kept at a minimum.**
- **Clothes lines are not permitted**
- **Each camper will securely wrap all garbage and trash in plastic bags and deposit them neatly in the Trash barrels. Each family is required to keep their area clean and tidy at all times.**

- **Campsites must be kept in a tidy, neat, and organized way. For the sake of safety, the campsite should be orderly to avoid creating a fire hazard or causing stumbling or falling accidents. For the sake of the campground's appeal as an outdoor recreation experience, each campsite should remain uncluttered and as naturalistic as possible.**
- **Campsite cannot be the camper's permanent residence.**
- **Preserve the natural plant life. Do not harm it, in any way!**

Campfires

- **All fires must be built in the fire rings provided for that purpose.**
- **No fire shall be started until all nearby flammable material has been removed to prevent its spread.**
- **Firewood cannot be gathered on site except from dead and down trees.**
- **Fires cannot be left unattended.**
- **No burning of treated or painted wood**

Pets

Pets are the sole and full responsibility of the owners and are liable for cleaning up after them, keeping them leashed and well behaved within the grounds. Disturbing the neighbors by the pets is not permitted.

- **Pets must be confined or leashed to restrict them to the campsite of the owner.**
- **Dogs cannot be left unattended. Barking or vicious dogs must be removed from the campground.**
- **Dogs may be walked on a leash - no longer than 6 feet, provided they are under control at all times.**
- **To ensure the enjoyment and safety of our visitors, If any pet is creating a disturbance or being a nuisance, the pet shall be immediately removed. OVER AND ABOVE THESE RULES, THE CAMPGROUND OWNER CAN, DENY ANY PET WHATSOEVER INTO THEIR CAMPGROUND.**

Safety

- **. Firearms – All kinds....air guns, BB guns, slingshots, paint guns and fireworks are prohibited.**
- **Excessive drinking, intoxication or foul language will not be permitted. The use of alcohol is not permitted under legal drinking age. Unsatisfactory behavior constitutes the cancellation of your camping contract without refund and camper must leave campground.**
- **No Life Guard on duty. Swim at your own risk.**
- **No climbing on the rocks, they are loose and dangerous.**
- **All the state of Tennessee rules apply when fishing. You must have a valid fishing license when fishing.**

Conveniences

Bath House & Restroom is to be used for registered campers only. Hot water shower and flush toilet are available. Please help us keep the facility clean and neat. Please contact staff if the facility needs attention. Remember, these are there for your convenience, Help us keep it clean.

Water – We are on well water, not city water. Please be considerate of your water usage. All hoses should be drip free. All vehicle washing is strictly prohibited. Please help us conserve one of our natural resources.

Piney River - While enjoying the Piney River, please be mindful of other property and land owners. Let's help keep the Piney River Clean.

River access. Ever though all sites are right on the water, most do not have direct access to the water. There are 3 access areas to the water. (1) is downstream from the campground, directly in front of the big barn. (2) is just upstream of campsite #6. (3) is upstream of campsite # 8.

In case of flood or high water – Directly across from the front gates, there are two gates leading to a field (High Ground). Any time there is danger of flooding, you can pull your RV to that area. If you are not around, and we can get your RV out, we will try. When leaving your RV for the season, we will need a extra key. Piney River Escape is not responsible for damage.
